By train

Manchester Oxford Road station is just opposite the hotel.

For those arriving at **Manchester Piccadilly**, the venue is 12-13 minutes walk from the station. Alternatively, you can take the free Bee Network city centre bus (Route 1) from the station and get off at the Palace Theatre, or the 147 bus, getting off at Princess Street.

For those arriving at **Manchester Victoria**, you can take Bee Network 41 bus and get off at Oxford Road, or any pink, green, red or navy line tram to St Peter's Square and walk down Oxford Road.

By bus

Bee Network bus routes 42B, 85, 111, 142, 143 and 147 stop outside or near the hotel.

Car parking

The Euro Car Parks Pritchard Street and JustPark Granby Row are nearby. Please note that traffic into Manchester can be very heavy after 7am and that parking spaces are limited.
